This week in 2nd Grade...

In <u>Religion</u> we learned about Jesus healing the sick boy and the blind man. During <u>Reading</u> we learned a bit about history, as we studied Mount Rushmore. We asked questions while reading our story, identified main ideas and details within the story, and we put important story words in alphabetical order. During <u>Phonics and Language</u> we learned about verb tenses, specifically focusing on past tense verbs, and we worked with contractions. We differentiated between contractions and possessive nouns, we reviewed tricky word pairs, and we reviewed plural versus possessive nouns. During <u>Math</u> we practiced multiplying by 0, 1, 2, 5, and 10. We recalled how we can use addition to help check our multiplication work, we identified related or opposite multiplication facts, and we used multiplication to solve word problems. During <u>Science</u> we learned about how the environment around us affects the sound we hear, and we learned about how our ears hear sounds. During <u>History</u> we concluded our chapter on the Middle Colonies. We then began studying the Southern Colonies, specifically focusing this week on Virginia and Maryland.
