This week in 2nd Grade...

In Religion we learned about the miraculous catch of fish and the Good Samaritan. During Reading we learned about leap year and what it would be like to have a birthday on leap day. We analyzed the main character in the story, worked with the "th" digraph, practiced putting story words in alphabetical order, and wrote letters to characters in the story. During Phonics and Language we reviewed contractions and differentiated between contractions and possessive nouns. We also reviewed suffixes and learned about prefixes. During Math we practiced multiplying by 3 and 4, as we concluded our chapter on multiplication facts. During Science we learned about pitch, as we concluded our section on sound. We then learned about light and the light spectrum. During History we continued studying the Middle Colonies, as we learned about North and South Carolina, and Georgia.

Homework reminders for the week of March 2-6:

Spelling: REVIEW WEEK!

It's time for a review week! We will be reviewing spelling patterns we have studied over the past weeks. Attached are suggested lists of words you may review at home with your child. We will be doing review activities in class, but students are encouraged to practice at home as well. I will assess each student's understanding of these spelling patterns on Friday, but we will not have a regular written spelling test.

Memory Work: Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. Luke 11:9

*Students should practice memory work at home so they are ready to say it by Friday.

Reading/Vocabulary: We will be reading the story "Crows Share a Pie." There will be a vocabulary quiz and a reading test Friday.

Vocabulary: glide, swoop, equal, half, fourth, one-eighth

AR (Accelerated Reader): Students should be encouraged to read for AR! In 2nd grade, AR medals are awarded when a student reaches 15, 25, 40, 60, 80 and 100 points. Students may take AR tests throughout the week as they are ready.
