This week in 2nd Grade...

In <u>Religion</u> we learned about Jesus bringing the widow's son back to life and we learned about Jesus calming the storm. During <u>Reading</u> we made connections while reading the story, practiced summarizing and retelling parts of the story, and identified main ideas and details within chapters of the story. We wondered what life would be like if we had some of the unique animal senses described in our story. During <u>Phonics and Language</u> we reviewed nouns and verbs, subjects and predicates. We identified subjects, predicates, nouns, and verbs within sentences, and we learned about subject-verb agreement. We also began diagramming simple sentences to help us identify the main parts of a sentence. During <u>Math</u> we multiplied both vertically and horizontally, we practiced our problem-solving skills, and we concluded our chapter on the introduction to multiplication. We then reviewed three-digit addition so we could begin exploring three-digit subtraction. During <u>Science</u> we concluded our unit on simple machines, and we began learning about sound. During <u>History</u> we learned about the Quakers and William Penn, and we learned about the starting of Pennsylvania and Delaware.
