This week in 2nd Grade...

In <u>Religion</u> we learned about Epiphany and the wise men visiting Jesus. We also learned about Mary and Joseph taking young Jesus to the temple. During <u>Reading</u> we made predictions while reading our story, practiced retelling our story, worked with nouns and adjectives, and sorted words with different long "e" spelling patterns. During <u>Phonics and Language</u> we reviewed the rules for making words plural, and we learned about irregular plural nouns. During <u>Math</u> we began adding three-digit numbers by counting on groups of one hundred, decomposing numbers, and adding with renaming. During <u>Science</u> we began learning about simple machines. The first two simple machines we explored were inclined planes and wedges. During <u>History</u> we learned about the first English colonies in America. We learned about the Pilgrims' journey on the Mayflower, and we learned about life in Plymouth. We also learned about Massachusetts Bay Colony, and we learned about how the early settlers got along with the Native Americans.
