This week in 2nd Grade...

In Religion we learned about Epiphany and the wise men visiting Jesus. We also learned about Mary and Joseph taking young Jesus to the temple. During Reading we made predictions while reading our story, practiced retelling our story, worked with nouns and adjectives, and sorted words with different long "e" spelling patterns. During Phonics and Language we reviewed the rules for making words plural, and we learned about irregular plural nouns. During Math we began adding three-digit numbers by counting on groups of one hundred, decomposing numbers, and adding with renaming. During Science we began learning about simple machines. The first two simple machines we explored were inclined planes and wedges. During History we learned about the first English colonies in America. We learned about the Pilgrims' journey on the Mayflower, and we learned about life in Plymouth. We also learned about Massachusetts Bay Colony, and we learned about how the early settlers got along with the Native Americans.
