This week in 2nd Grade...

In <u>Religion</u> we learned about Jesus' baptism and Jesus calling his disciples. During <u>Reading</u> we made connections to our own lives while reading our story, analyzed problems and solutions within the story, worked with subjects and predicates, and practiced putting story words in alphabetical order. During <u>Phonics and Language</u> we learned about possessive nouns and we differentiated between plural and possessive nouns. We also worked with compound words, reviewed common versus proper nouns, and we learned about abbreviations for personal titles. During <u>Math</u> we concluded our chapter on three-digit addition, and we began working with money. During <u>Science</u> we learned about nails versus screws, and we explored the benefits of using screws as a simple machine. During <u>History</u> we located the rest of the New England Colonies on a map, we learned about life in New England, and we explored the education system in the New England Colonies.
