This week in 2nd Grade...

In Religion we learned about Jesus changing water to wine at a wedding, and we learned about Jesus blessing the children. During Reading we made connections and analyzed the characters while reading the story. We also worked with synonyms and conjunctions, and we did fun writing activities to go along with our story. During Phonics and Language we learned more about capitalization rules and we continued working with abbreviations. We also reviewed possessive nouns versus plural nouns, and we reviewed rules for adding suffixes to words. During Math we practiced adding and subtracting money amounts and we reviewed important problem-solving strategies as we concluded our chapter on money. During Science we learned about levers and wheels and axles. During History we learned about the Great Awakening as we concluded our chapter on the New England Colonies. We also learned about Martin Luther King Jr.
