## This week in 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade...

In <u>Religion</u> we learned about Jesus healing the paralyzed man and the ten lepers. During <u>Reading</u> we made predictions while reading our story, analyzed the main character in the story, practiced using quotation marks, and shared our own experiences with competitions. During <u>Phonics and Language</u> we reviewed common versus proper nouns, abbreviations, capitalization rules, and plural versus possessive nouns. We also began learning more about commas and verbs. During <u>Math</u> we began learning about multiplication. We related multiplication to addition, we pictured multiplication, and we wrote and solved multiplication sentences. We also learned about arrays and how they can help us picture multiplication problems. During <u>Science</u> we learned about pulleys. We reviewed all the simple machines, as we explored school and classroom machines. The students also enjoyed sharing their science fair projects! During <u>History</u> we reviewed the New England Colonies, as we began learning about the Middle Colonies. We also learned about trading posts. We enjoyed celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School!
