This week in 2nd Grade...

In <u>Religion</u> we learned about Jesus visiting Mary and Martha, and the Widow's Mite. During <u>Reading</u> we connected our story to our math lessons on fractions, and we discussed the importance of sharing. We identified main ideas and details within the story, worked with "r" blends, reviewed synonyms and antonyms, and learned about thesauruses. During <u>Phonics and Language</u> we reviewed prefixes, suffixes, synonyms, antonyms, and other past lesson concepts. During <u>Math</u> we connected our lessons on fractions to our reading story this week. We compared fractions and applied fractions to parts of a set of objects. During <u>Science</u> we learned about why objects appear to be certain colors, and we concluded our unit on sound and light. During <u>History</u> we learned about farming, plantations, and slaves in the Southern Colonies.
