
PK3 Daily Activity Schedule

9:30-10:00	Saxon Math (MWF): Curriculum based math skills (Listening, counting, sorting, etc.) Computers (T): Computer Lab, (Technology, math, reading, print awareness, vocabulary)



ACTIVITY:


- 1. Have kids use a q tip to paint the letter q.



- 4. Make copies of sentence strip.




- 1. Have kids glue the letter Q to the blue paper

- 3. Have kids glue sentence strip.


uppercase letter Q template
